### The Write Up

An Inter-School English Creative Writing Competition "**The Write Up**" was organized for classes IX and XI in the first week of February. The contest was organized under the aegis of "Battees" and "J. K. Paper Ltd". The teacher in charge for the competition was Mrs. Ruchika Sukhija.



The contest was a city-wide student challenge on the topic, "**Paper is relevant in the future**" to promote creative writing, language skills and to foster respect for research and critical thinking, while using paper as a tool for reflective writing. It is believed that writing with pen on paper improves articulation and comprehension. Thus, the

contest was an opportunity for aspiring writers to learn more and be encouraged.

Every student had to write for and against the topic as well as a conclusion where they had to take a stand. The total word limit for the entire write up was 1000 words.

Over 70 reputed schools such as Army Public School, Kerela Education Senior Secondary School, S.D.Public School, etc participated in the contest and there were around 10,000 entries. 12 selected entries were forwarded from our school. Our students brought laurels to their alma mater by proving their mettle. It is a matter of pride for all of us that **5 out of 19 winning entries were of our school.**

On Friday; 25<sup>th</sup> April;2018, in a glittering award ceremony held at Constitution Club of India, Sansad Marg, our students were awarded for their efforts.

**Awdhendra Pratap Singh, Class 12 A, stood first among 10,000 students who participated in the competition. He was rewarded with a trophy, a cheque of Rs 15,000 and a set of 10 books written by Paulo Coelho.**

The entry of **Neeraj Jain, Class 12 A**, was given a “**Special Mention Prize**”. He was given a trophy, an appreciation certificate and a set of 10 books authored by Paulo Coelho.

Other students who were recognized are **Ishita Gupta, Class 12A, Prateek Aggarwal, Class 12A and Vishesh Aggarwal, Class 10.**
