Dear Parents,

Holidays are always a welcome break from a normal routine and we all look forward to them. It is the best time for acquiring many new skills and learning new habits. Since English is a universal language, we want our children to be proficient in speaking it and for this we need your full support and cooperation. We would appreciate if you adhere to the following points:

1. Speak with your child in English. Encourage reading habits.
2. Read out story- books and after finishing the story discuss it with your child.
3. The teachers are trying to encourage the children to use simple words, phrases or sentences like :-
 - May I go to play?
 - May I borrow your pencil/ eraser/ sharpener?
 - I have finished my work.
 - Ma'am, may I go to the washroom?
 - Ma'am, may I go to drink water?
 - Madam, may I come in please?
 - Ma'am, may I go to wash my hands?
 - Ma'am, may I go to pay my school fees?
 - Madam, may I sit in the front row as I can't see from the back?
 - Madam, please repeat the concept I am unable to understand it.
 - Ma'am, I have lost my shoes / blazer/ tiffin box/ water bottle etc.
 - Ma'am I came late as I missed my bus.
 - Ma'am, I am sorry. I have forgotten to bring my book, notebook, pencil/ eraser/drawing book etc.
 - Madam, may I borrow a pencil/ eraser/ ruler etc. from my partner as I have forgotten to bring it today.
 - Could you hand me the book?
 - Could you please shut the door?

Use of magic words like excuse me, sorry, thanks, please.

- When asking for something, say " Please."
- When receiving something, say " Thank you."
- Do not interrupt grown-ups who are speaking with each other unless there is an emergency.
- When you have any doubt about doing something, ask permission first. It can save you from many hours of grief later.

Children can be encouraged to use simple words and sentences at home also. For example,

- Mummy, can I help you in the kitchen?
- Mummy, can I lay the table today?
- Papa, can I help you wash the car?
- Should I come with you for a walk?
- Mummy, can I get you a glass of water?

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- Mummy, may I take some more Ice- cream from the fridge?
- Papa, please teach me how to ride a bicycle.
- Mummy, can I join the summer workshop in the school?
- Mummy, can you teach me how to make cold coffee please?
- Didi, can you help me find my English note book?
- Papa, can we go cycling together?

Wishing people properly---- Hello Uncle/ Aunty ! How are you?

Wishing elders and parents ; Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Good Evening and Good Night.

If we, as teachers and parents make a sincere effort and pay attention to the above mentioned points.

We can help our children to learn, to understand and speak English at an early age.
