### **Prevention and Control of Vector-Borne Diseases**

Dear Mahavirians and Parents,

**As the monsoon season approaches, we would like to bring to your attention the importance of preventing and controlling vector-borne diseases such as Dengue, Chikungunya, and Malaria. These three major mosquito-borne diseases are a significant concern in Delhi and can sometimes gain epidemic proportions if preventive measures are not taken.**

**Prevention is the best method to control any disease, and it is essential that we take collective efforts to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes. To control and prevent the outbreak of Dengue, Chikungunya, and Malaria, we request your cooperation in implementing the following measures:**

- ❖ Students must wear their uniform, which comprises full-sleeve shirts and trousers/skirts with socks.
- ❖ We must use mosquito repellents to avoid mosquito bites.
- ❖ No collection of stagnant water should be allowed anywhere.
- ❖ All water tanks and containers should be covered with well-fitted lids to prevent breeding of mosquitoes.
- ❖ All unused containers, such as junk materials, tyres, coconut shells, used plastic cups, glasses, bottles, and pots, etc., should be properly disposed of.

**By taking these simple yet effective measures, we can significantly reduce the risk of mosquito-borne diseases. We urge all students and parents to take responsibility for their own health and safety, as well as that of their community.**

**Let us work together to keep our home, school and surroundings mosquito-free and ensure a healthy and safe environment for everyone.**
