## *Aryabhata Ganit Challenge 2023*

Recognising the importance of nurturing mathematical competencies among students and encouraging the practical application of Mathematics, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) conducts the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge, for classes VIII - X, annually.

The Aryabhata Ganit Challenge is divided into two levels.

Level 1: School Level Competition which was held in September.



The competition at this level serves as the first stage of the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge.

Level 2: National Level Competition. CBSE conducts the second level as a computer-based test.

This year, around 5,50,000 students witnessed the enthusiastic participation from around 5050 schools at the school level and 8,590 students participated in national level at second stage. Upon successful completion of the second stage, the top 100 students from each CBSE region are conferred with a Merit certificate.

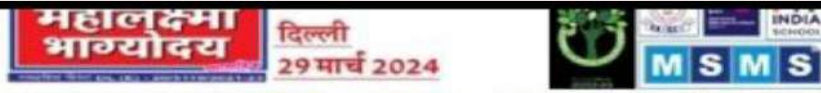

Bharati Bhawan, Publishers and Distributors organised a workshop on  
Developing English language skills.

The workshop was attended by English faculty, MSMS.



The session dealt with practical, low-prep activities meant for teaching different skills involved in teaching English to non-native learners of English language.

The speaker insisted that by having tasks for which there are no wrong answers, learners' confidence is boosted, they become creative and learn how to think outside the box.

All the activities discussed in the workshop could be adapted to different ages and levels eg. Lolly Lotto, Bingo, Collaborative Reading etc. and can be used with any coursebook/materials. The speaker emphasised that reading is Thinking. It can develop skills to predict by using clues, infer, visual use, question and connect and should be combined with the key components of ELT, including language acquisition, learning communication skills and cultural awareness. To ensure learning by all the learners, different learning methods and approaches should be adopted. The resource person focussed on how process based approaches, task based instruction and process based, competency, building instructional methods can help in acquisition of English language.

This workshop gave English language teachers creative ideas to design and scaffold practical and fun learning experiences for all learners to help them in their career journey. Framing lesson objectives to help language learners for developing linguistic

skills were discussed, with focus on teaching English on the lines of the NEP emphasising the importance of literacy and social interaction.

The teachers were entreated to use figurative language to engage their audiences, using a more creative tone that provokes thinking and sometimes humour as well. The session included a number of activities that teachers can use in their class rooms with special focus on handling learners of English as a Second Language. Activities like 'Dictation', 'Completing Stories', 'Imaginative Stories' (based on grammar topics like prepositions) and TPR (total physical response) were taken up.





The session was a great learning experience for the teachers as it provided new avenues for them in the areas of teaching English effectively and implementing the strategies of NEP.

The workshop highlighted innovative approaches and interactive activities for teaching vocabulary and grammar that would, in turn, enable learners to develop and improve their language skills.

### **INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION**

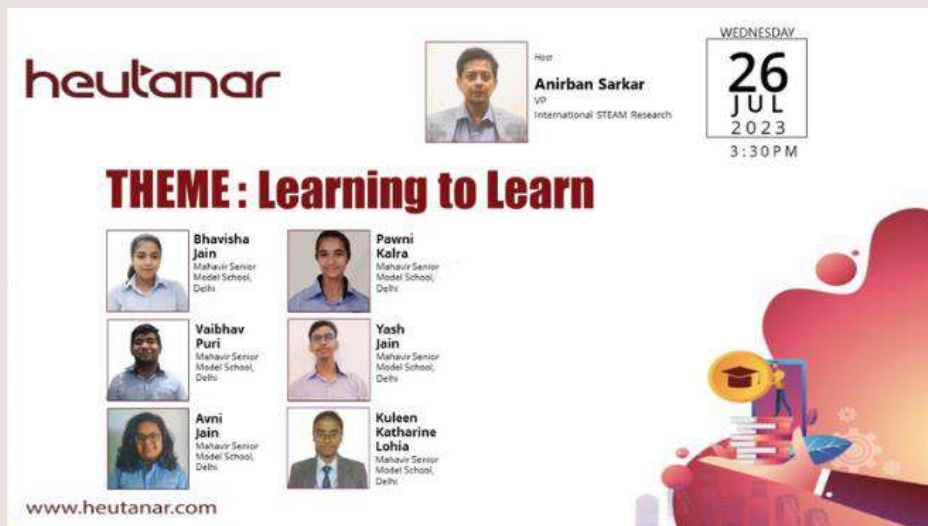

## Class VII

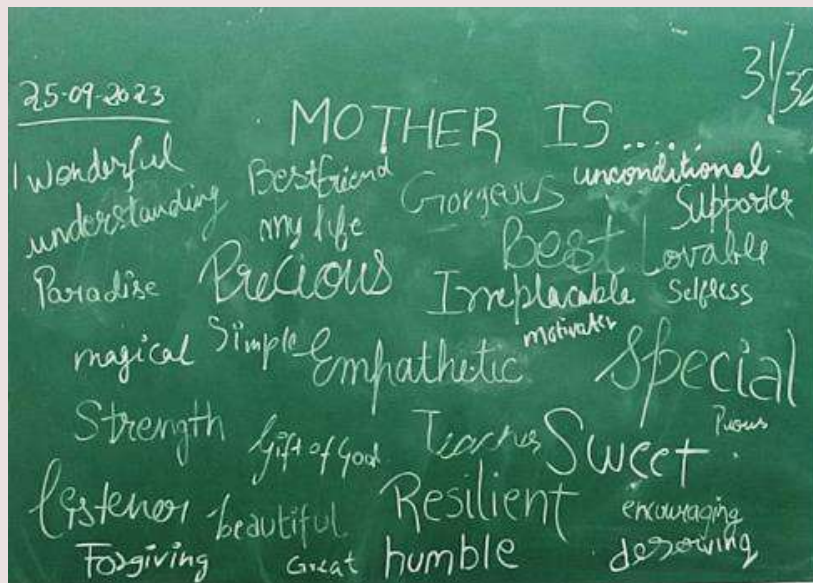
### Vocabulary Word Web

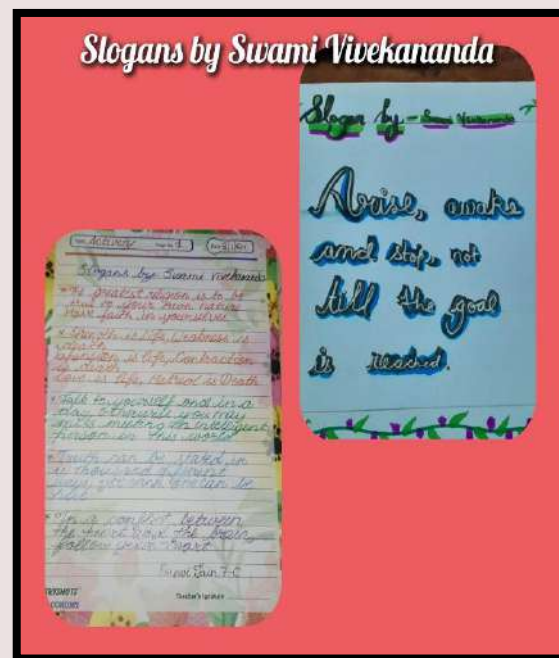
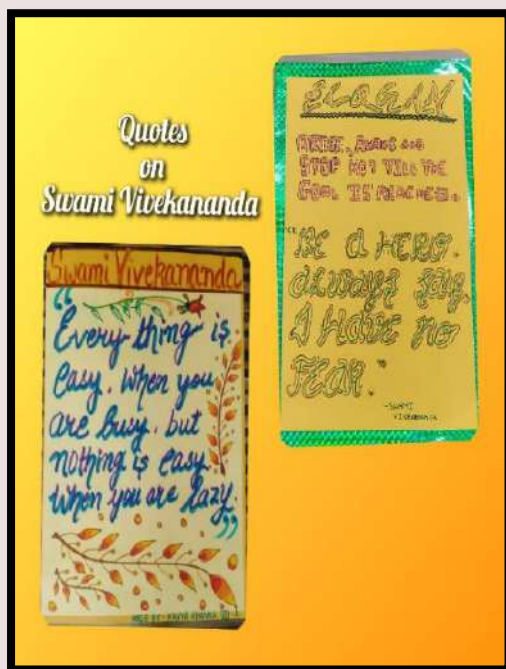
Department encouraged students to make New Year greeting cards and think

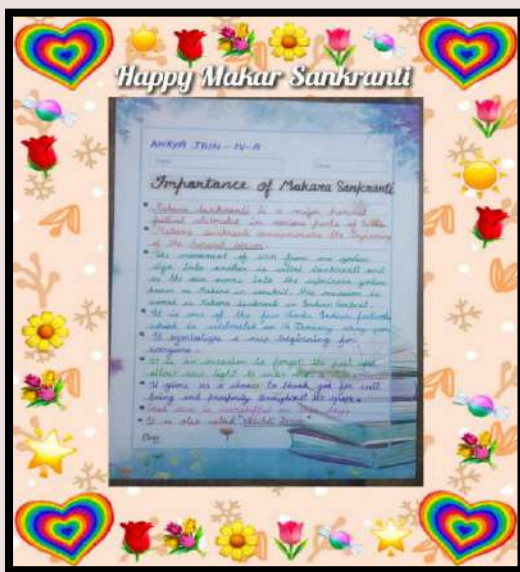


### **Lohri and Makar Sankranti**

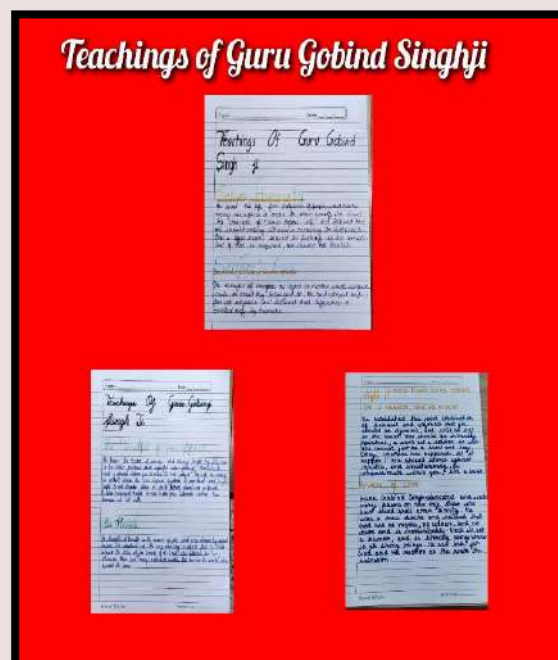
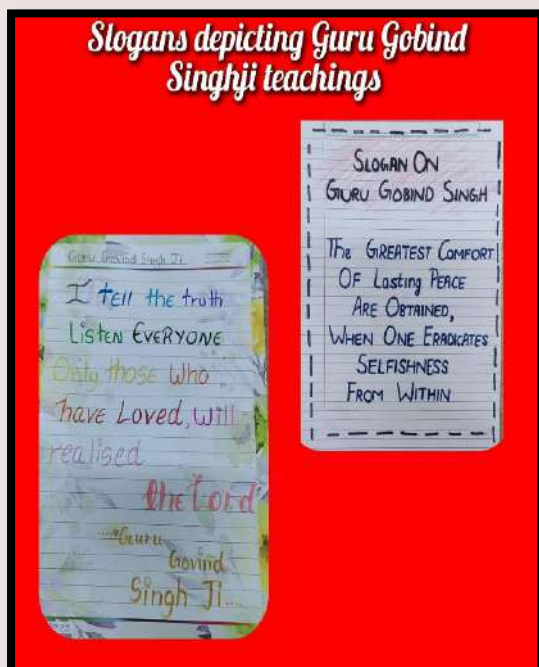

## Birth Anniversary of Guru Gobind Singh

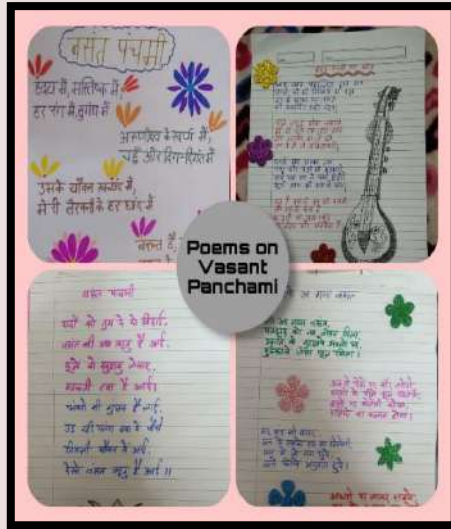

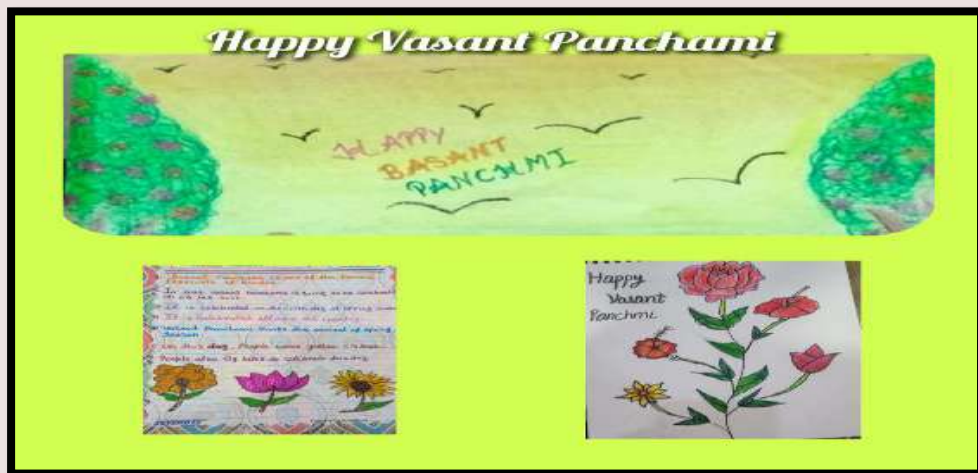
