गणित हमारे जीवन को व्यवस्थित व सुगम बनाता है। यह मानसिक अनुशासन के निर्माण का एक प्रभावी तरीका प्रदान करता है और तार्किक क्षमता के संतुलन को प्रोत्साहित करता है। गणित द्वारा पोषित कुछ गुण तर्क शक्ति, रचनात्मकता, संतुलित सोच, के साथ समस्या सुलझाने की क्षमता का प्रभावी संचार कौशल भी है।

महान भारतीय गणितज्ञ, श्रीनिवास रामानुजन की जयंती को स्मरण करते हुए प्रति वर्ष 22 दिसंबर को राष्ट्रीय गणित दिवस मनाया जाता है। गणित के महत्व और क्षेत्र में हुई प्रगति के संदर्भ में लोगों को जागरूक करने के उद्देश्य से यह दिवस मनाया जाता है।

महावीर सीनियर मॉडल स्कूल ने 'गणित सप्ताह' मनाने के लिए एक पहल की जिसमें सभी कक्षाओं के विद्यार्थियों के लिए विविध गतिविधियाँ / प्रतियोगिताएँ

The session was appreciated and it was believed that over the years we would see the personality change in our children through this programme.





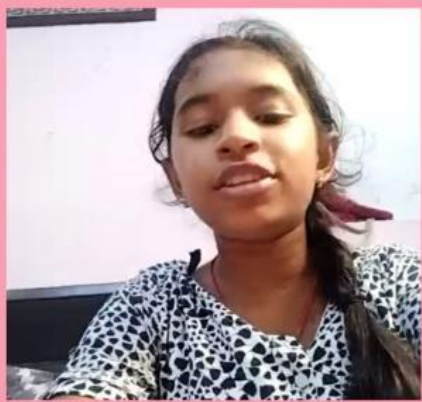

All the team members presented their business idea using a colourful prototype. Commerce students they should committed

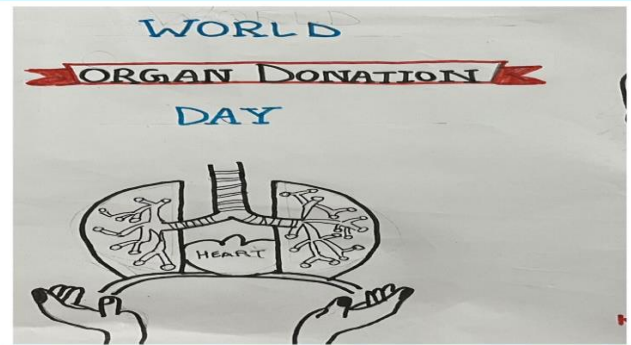

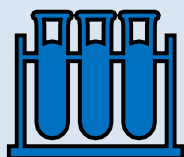


the guiding light for generations to come.

Students recited poems, wrote slogans, made creative and innovative caricatures of Gandhi Ji. They also narrated anecdote on life of Gandhi ji.

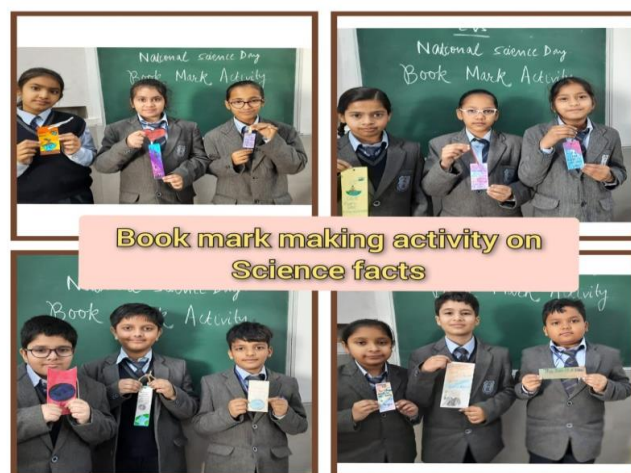



⊗The final Match was held between CRPF Public School and Bal Bharti School, Rohini

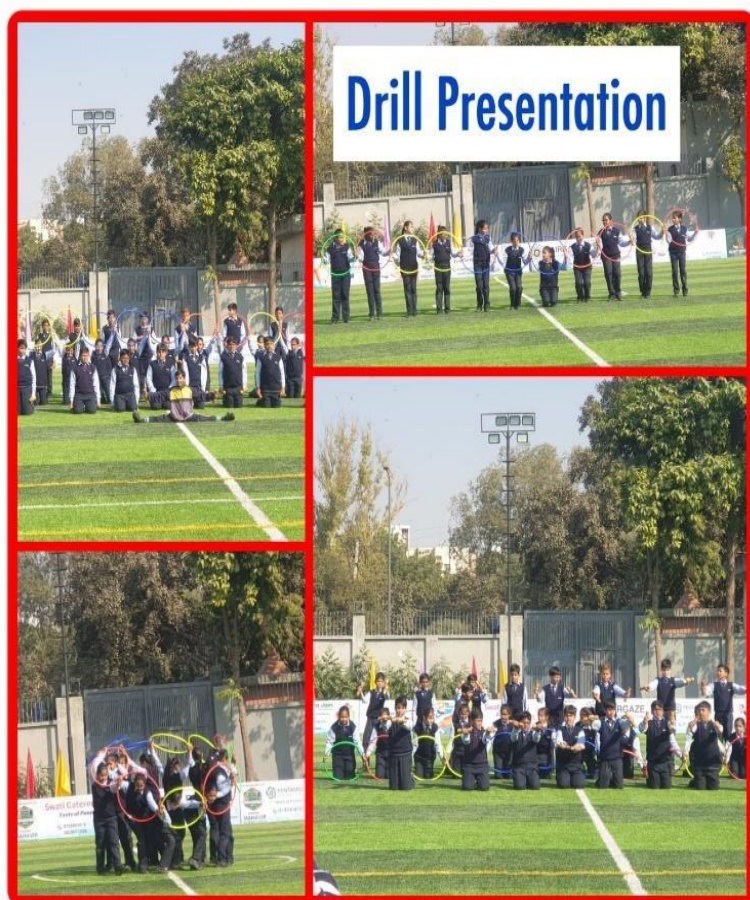

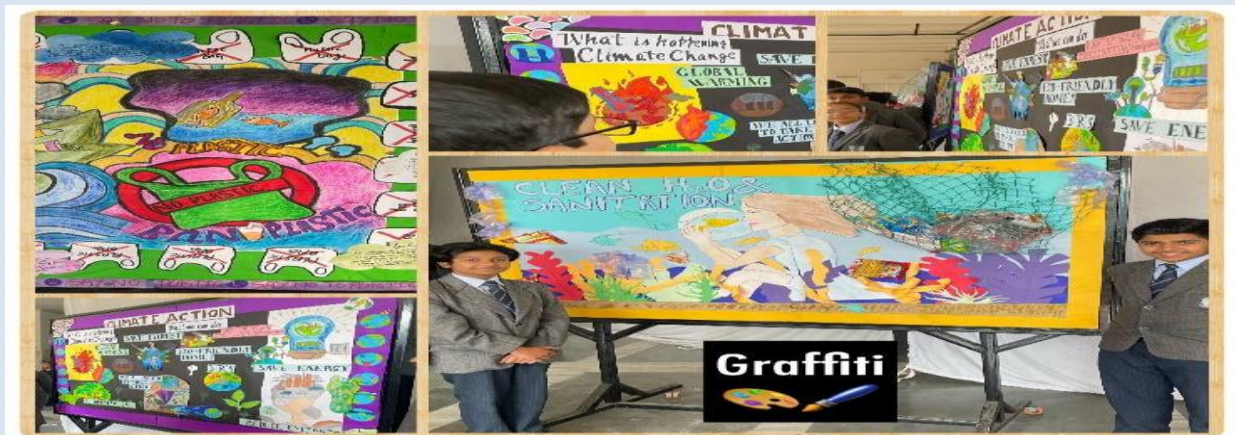
2. Fresh Feast - by Little Chefs

Class IX students made wonderful graffities on the topic - Goals of Sustainable Development. Six teams of 4 students each participated in this event.



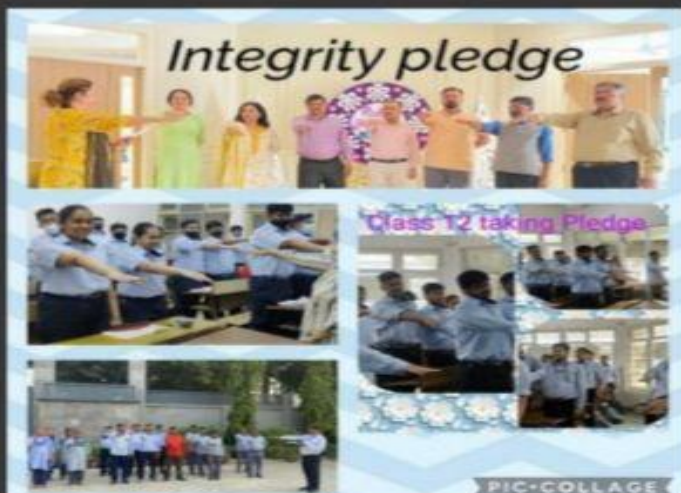


VIGILANCE WEEK

VIJAY DIWAS

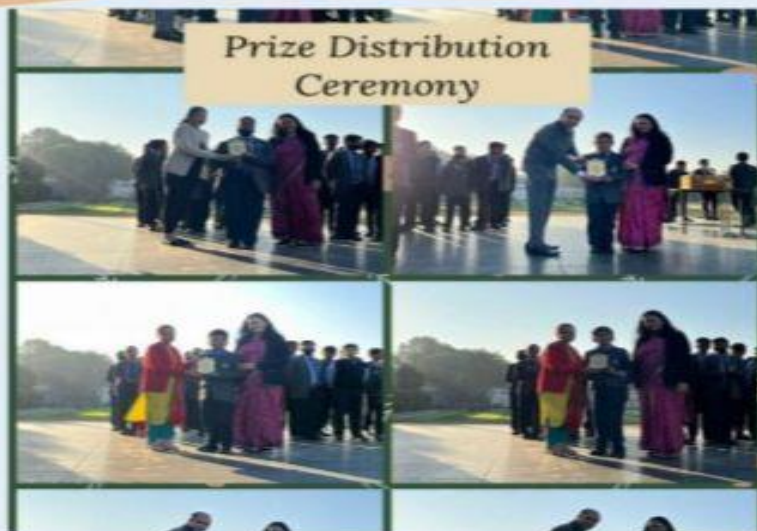


In commemoration of the historic military victory over Pakistan in the 1971 War, the students of class IX-C presented their assembly on the topic -Vijay Diwas

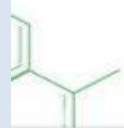

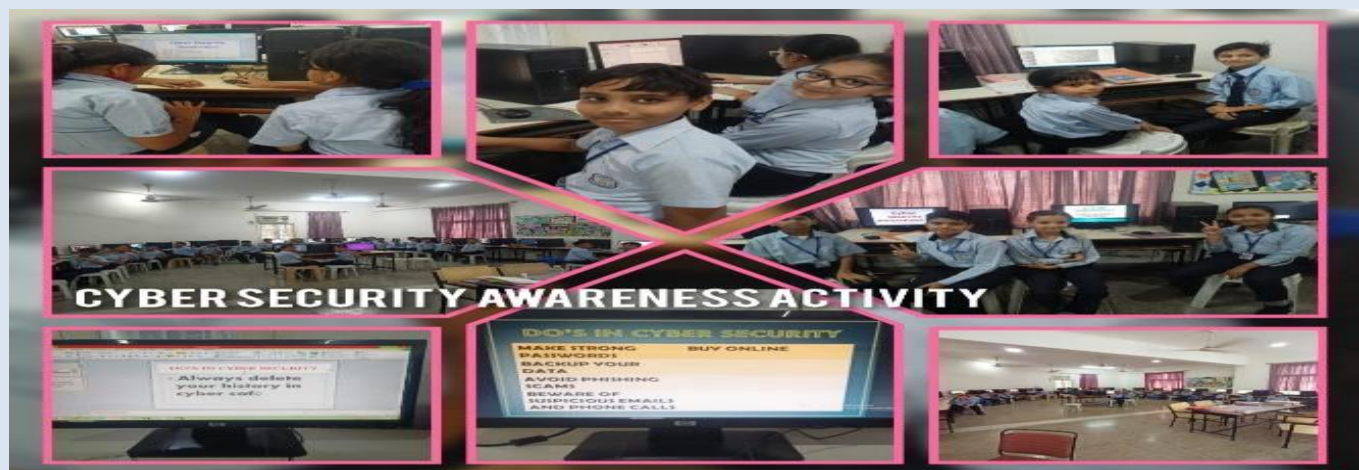
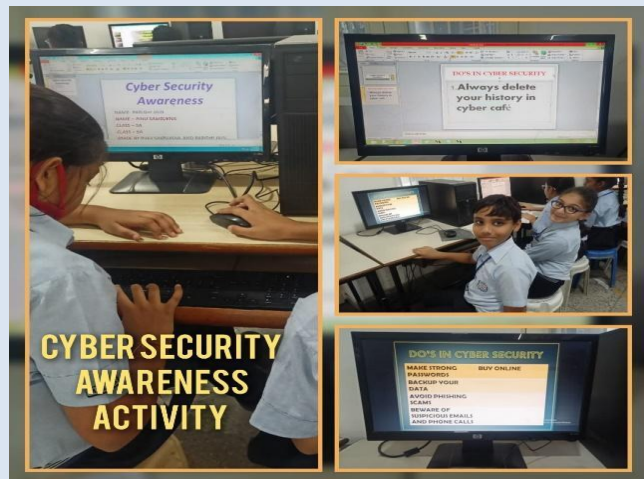


Theme : Let's Be safe from Cyber Crime.
