



Children were encouraged to help the parents in daily household chores and to eat atleast one meal of the day with the family.








### Welcome To Sikkim



To expose the students to a diverse range of opportunities to build clarity about their goals; and empower them to pursue internships, jobs and leadership experiences they find personally meaningful.










#### INTER SCHOOL COMPETITION

### VIJAY DIWAS




In commemoration of the historic military victory over Pakistan in the 1971 War, the students of class IX-C presented their assembly on the topic –Vijay Diwas


