

### Theme: Mental Health is Universal Human Right










### A moment of pride for MSMS!






### International Commerce








### Exploring the Halls of Justice: Mahavir Senior Model School Students Visit Supreme Court






## "INTER CLASS ENTREPRENEURIAL COMPETITION"



### FINDING YOUR IKIGAI



### **Rain Water Harvesting**

Date: 08.01.2024 Class VII and VIII

The future is green energy, sustainability and renewable energy Students from Class VII and Class VIII had the opportunity to visit the rainwater harvesting plant located within the school premises. The purpose of the visit was to enhance students' understanding of sustainable water management practices.

The rainwater harvesting plant at our school is a Japanese Technology System designed to collect and store rainwater for various purposes. The facility includes a network of pits and storage blocks strategically placed across the school ground to maximize water collection efficiency. The collected rainwater is then filtered and stored in underground tanks for later use. Explanation of components: The students received a detailed explanation of the different components of the rainwater harvesting system, including the pits, filtration unit, and storage tanks.

Demonstration: A practical demonstration was conducted to showcase how rainwater is collected, filtered and stored. Video and pictures of the plant were also shared with students. Environmental Benefits: The educational session emphasized the environmental benefits of rainwater harvesting such as reducing wastage of water sources and replenishing groundwater levels. Role in Water Conservation: Students were informed about the crucial role that rainwater harvesting plays in water conservation, especially in regions facing water scarcity. The visit aimed to develop a sense of responsibility among students towards sustainable water usage.


### REPORT ON INTER CLASS MOCK POLICY COMPETITION

# Brochure making on Ocean Movements Class: VII






A class activity was conducted with the students of class VII to make them understand Ocean Movements.








Class-II B Friday 18th August
