# Oral Hygiene and Dental Check-up Camp

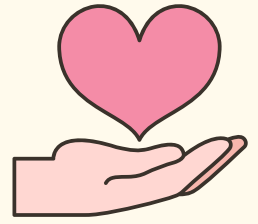
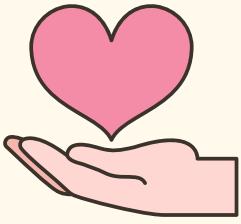

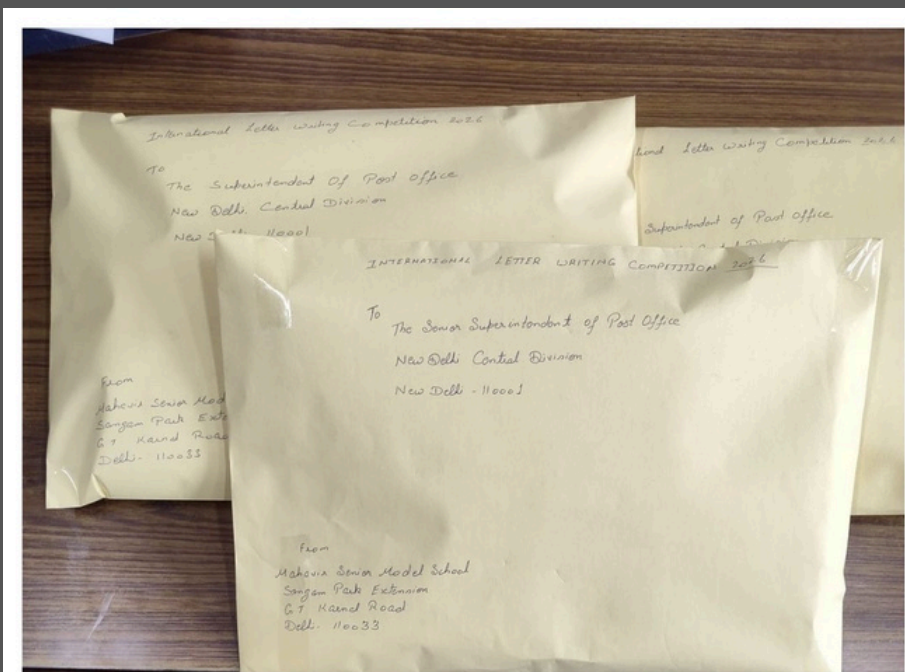


# LETTER WRITING COMPETITION

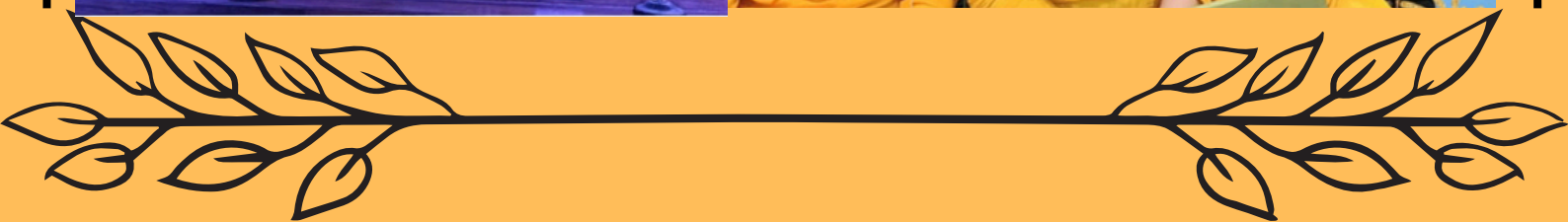

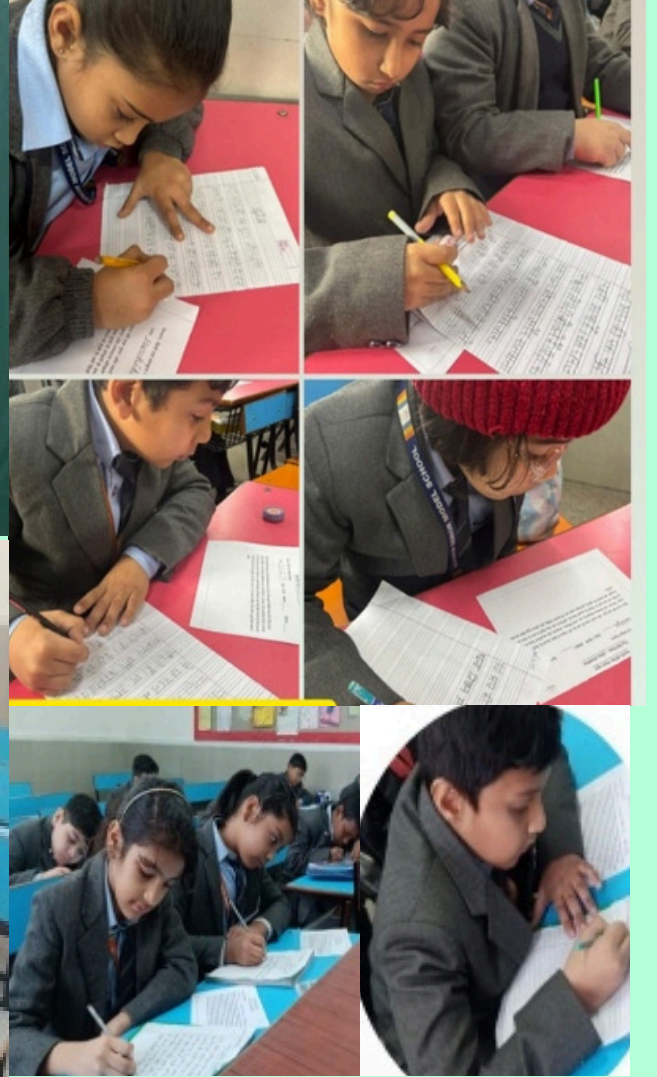
# विश्व हिंदी दिवस

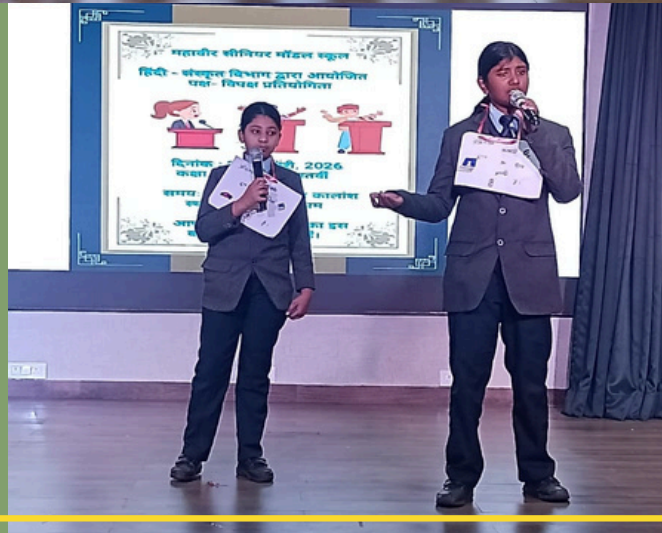


# समसामयिक चिंतन और अभिव्यक्ति : पक्ष-विपक्ष प्रतियोगिता का आयोजन

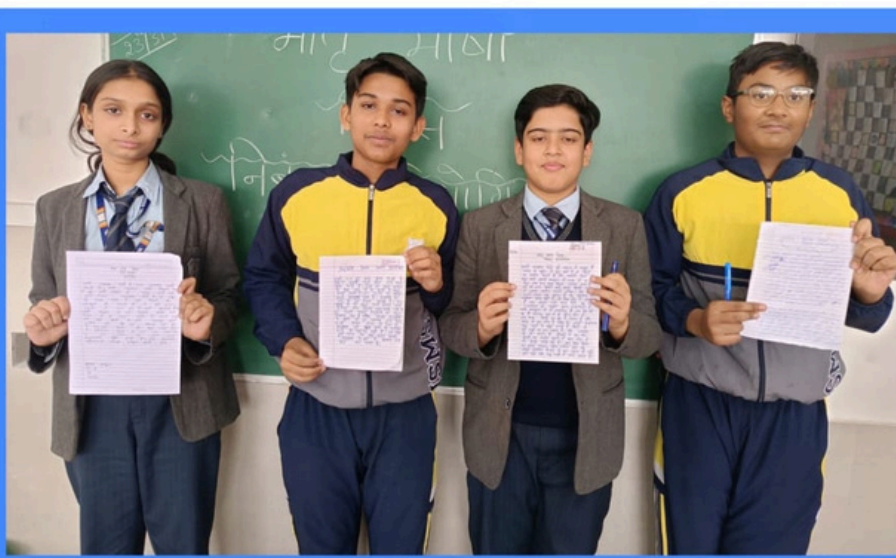

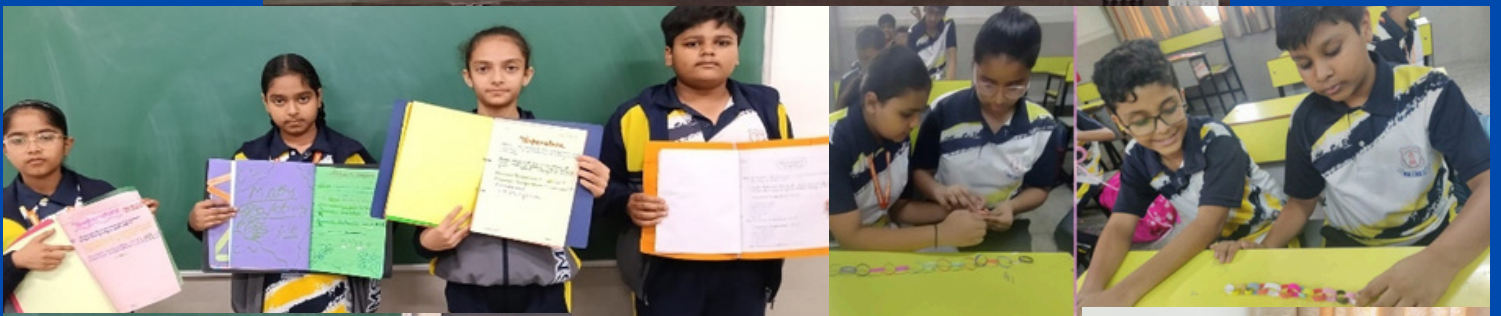

# Mathematics - Class Activities

The first group of activities focused on making abstract mathematical concepts tangible through art and storytelling. Students utilized visual aids like the "Fraction Multiplication Fusion" grids and "Factor Rainbows" to see the relationships between numbers in a colorful, intuitive way. This creative approach extended to the "Infinity Pi Chain," which visualized the non-repeating decimals of  $\pi$  through color-coded links, and the "Living Legends" competition, where students personified the history of mathematics. By designing witty memes and constructing "Robo Metrics" through coloring, students were able to engage with the subject's logic through an artistic lens, making learning both memorable and lighthearted.



# Mathematics - Class Activities

The second group of activities shifted the focus toward the practical utility of mathematics in everyday life and professional fields. Through projects like the "Temperature Decoder" and "Pi Day Recipe Activity," students learned the vital role of conversion and proportional reasoning in daily tasks. Older students moved into more complex territory with "Strength in Triangles," where they applied geometric principles to bridge engineering, and the "Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat" project, which used statistical tools like bar graphs and pie charts to interpret demographic data. These activities, alongside explorations of ancient number systems, demonstrated how mathematics serves as a foundational tool for solving real-world problems and understanding the evolution of human progress.

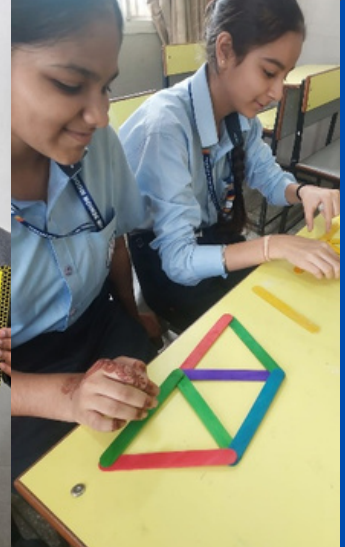


## The Babylonian System

## Grade V English Intraclass Competition

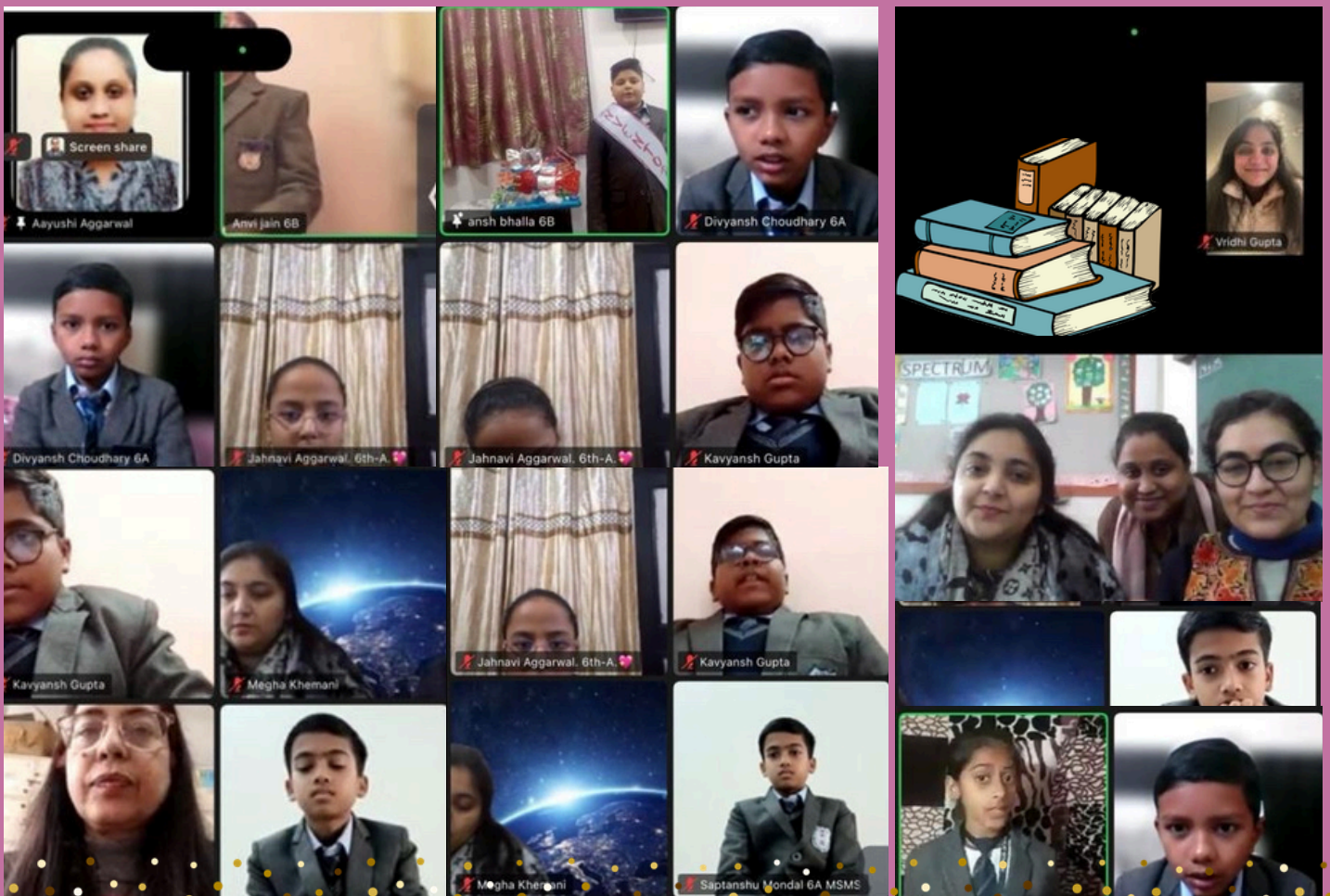

# CBSE National Adolescent Summit 2025

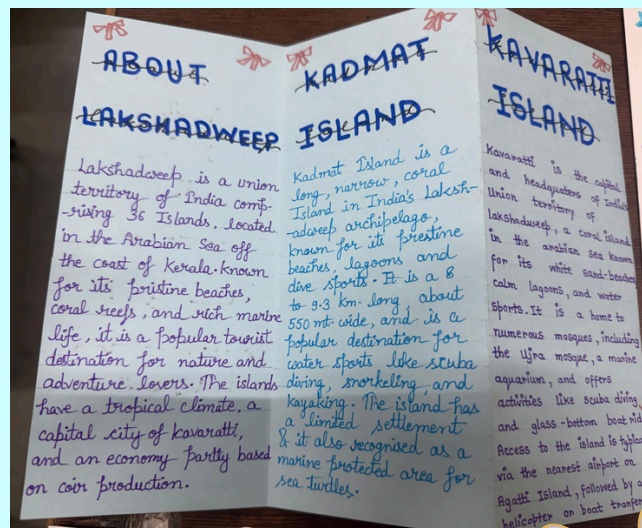
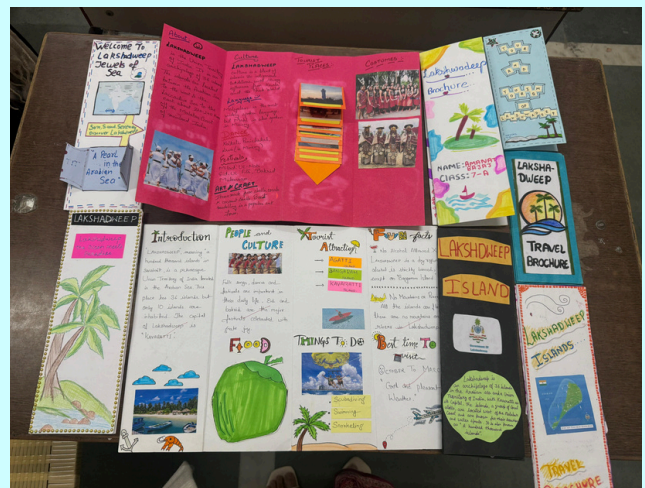
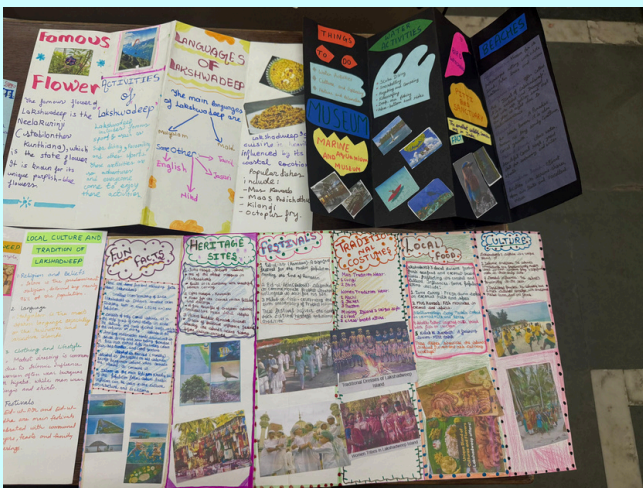

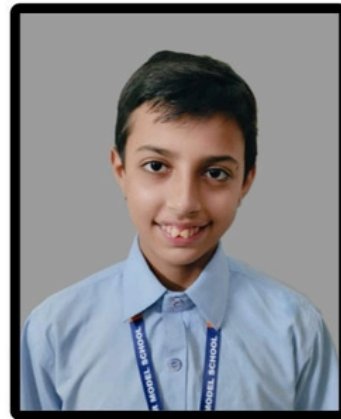
# COLOURS OF PATRIOTISM, STROKES OF VICTORY

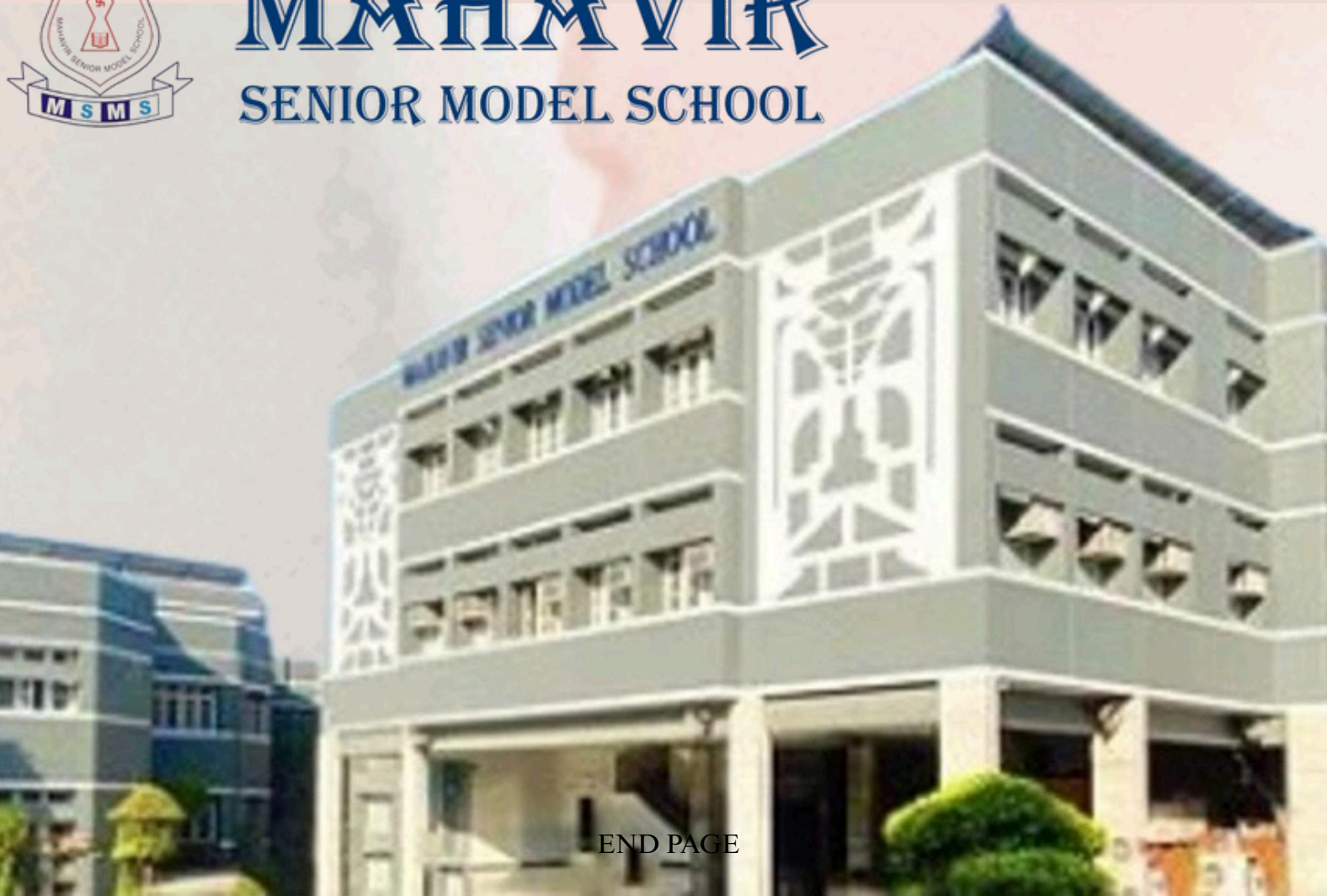
