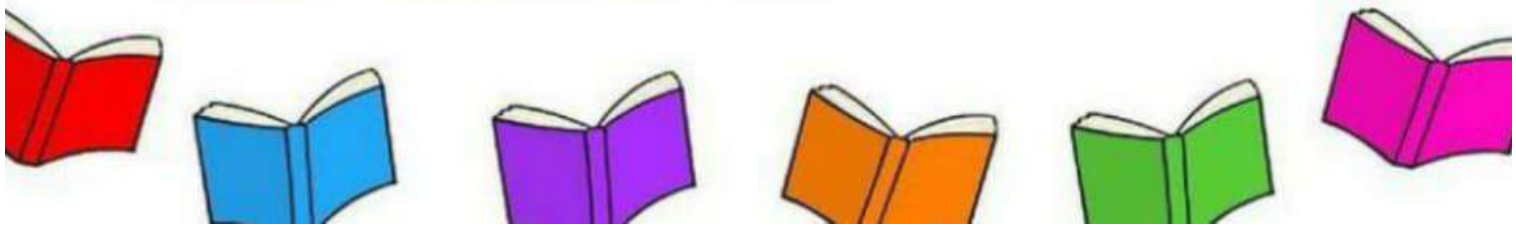
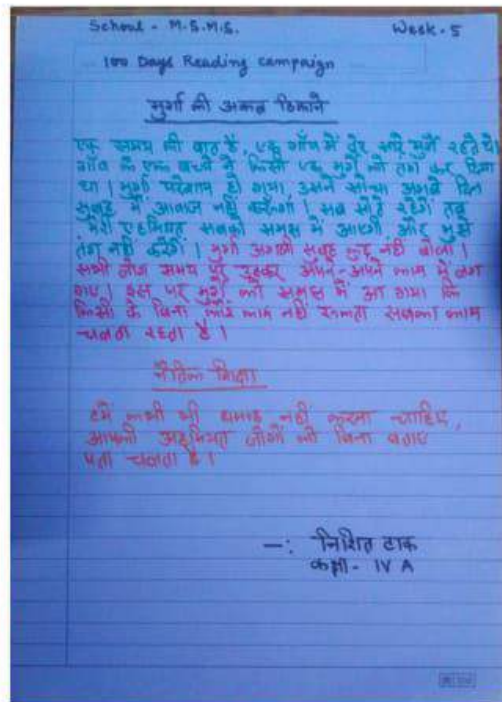
Shreya and Mira are having an interview about their favorite story Secret Seven.

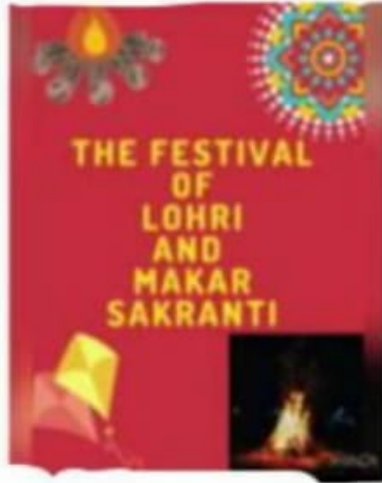
Shreya: Hello Mira! Are you excited for the interview?
