SECTION B: WRITING AND GRAMMAR 30 MARKS

Q. 3: Write an Article/ Descriptive Paragraph (person/ place/event/diary entry) in about 100-150 words based on visual or verbal cue/s The question will be thematically based on the prescribed books.

- Q.4: Writing a short story based on a given outline or cue/s in about 150 -200 words.
- Q.5: Gap filling with one or two words to test Prepositions, Articles, conjunctions and Tenses.

Q.7.: Sentences reordering or sentence transformation in context.

- Q. 9. Five Short Answer Type Questions from BEEHIVE AND MOMENTS (3 questions from BEEHIVE and 2 questions from Moments) to test local and global comprehension of theme and ideas (30-40 words each 2x5 = 10 marks.
- Q. 10. One out of two long answer type questions from the book BEEHIVE to assess Creativity, imagination and extrapolation beyond the text and across the texts.

 (100-150 words) 8 marks.
- Q.11. One out of two Long Answer Questions from the book MOMENTS on theme or plot involving interpretation, extrapolation beyond the text and inference or character sketh in about 100-150 words.
