
Dear Parents

Safety and Security of our students is one of our prime concerns. In the interest of the security and safety of all students, parents are requested to adhere to the following guidelines issued by School Management / Directorate of Education.

- Parents of children using private vans / rickshaws should ensure that the drivers have proper Police Verification / Police Clearance Certificate.
- The school regularly holds workshops for children to sensitize them on various pertinent topics like good touch-bad touch, road safety, bullying, cyber safety, disaster management etc. Parents should also train their wards regarding these critical issues.
- Parents should not allow their children to bring any motorized vehicle to the school. We do not wish to encourage kids to ride bikes/ scooters/ cars to school. This is necessary for the safety of the child.
- Students are not allowed to go to their home in between the school hours. In case of emergency, only parents should come to pick up their ward from the school. Please do not send the elder sibling or any other relative.
- Parents are requested to ensure that their wards should not wear jewelry or carry expensive gadgets or mobile phones to the school.
- It is mandatory to intimate the school authorities regarding any change in Address and Phone number.
- No Parent is allowed to meet the teachers/counsellor/ Principal/Director during the school hours as they are busy with the students during this time. Parents are requested to meet them only after the school hours, after seeking prior appointment.
- At home, kindly keep a watch on your children while they are using Internet, Mobile Phones, Laptops, Desktops etc.
- Parents should spend quality time with their wards every day. We request you to develop a strong bond with your ward that empowers him/her with strong ethical and moral values.
